Site Review

Every piece of land is different. Skilled contractors look at the slope, soil, and drainage to make sure that the surface won't hold water near sidewalks or foundations.

Digging and getting the base ready

They take off old surfaces and soft spots. To make a strong, stable base, crushed stone base layers are compacted. If the grading is done right, water will flow away on its own.

Putting down asphalt

Depending on how much traffic is expected, hot mix asphalt is spread out evenly in one or more lifts. Edges are tightly packed to make the structure stronger. Smooth rolling gets rid of flaws and makes sure the finish is perfect.

Last Touches

A polished, finished look comes from clean lines, neat edges, and optional decorative borders. After it cools down, the driveway can be used lightly in 24 hours.

How to Keep It Working for a Long Time

To protect against water and UV damage, sealcoat every three to five years.

To keep stains and dirt from building up, clean often.

If you take care of them, asphalt driveways can last 20 to 25 years. If you don't, they only last half as long.
